March 11, 2020 - UPDATE

In Hanover Area School District the health, safety and well-being of our students and staff are our top priorities. With the recently elevated discussion regarding the coronavirus disease (COVID-19), we want to take a moment to reinforce preventive safety measures and reference our process and communications.

Effective immediately, the following procedures will be mandatory in the Hanover Area School District

If any of the following apply to your student(s) they will be placed on a 14-day leave and be required to supply a doctor's note clearing them to return to school:

- Students who have been out of the Continental United States in the last 2 weeks
- Students who have been in an area that has a recent confirmed case of the Coronavirus
- * Students that have been exposed to a person with a confirmed case of COVID-19

Once this paperwork is complete you will be contacted by the school to set up date to finalize registration at the district office.

We all play a role in reducing the likelihood of a coronavirus outbreak in our school district community. We encourage everyone to practice good habits, including:

- Wash your hands regularly, especially after using the restroom and before preparing or consuming food. Using soap and hot water, wash for about 20 seconds. Be sure to also wash your fingertips.
- Avoid coughing or sneezing into your hands or in the air. Always try to cough or sneeze into a tissue, and then throw the tissue away. If you don't have a tissue, cough/sneeze into your arm.
- As much as you can, avoid touching your eyes, mouth and nose.
- If children are feeling sick, please keep them home from school. Allow them some time to feel better so that they do not risk infecting others.

At this time, there have only been a small number of confirmed cases of coronavirus in the United States. As a school district, we are closely monitoring the situation and taking guidance from the Pennsylvania Department of Health and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
