## ***PRIDE* Mission**

*PRIDE* is a Positive Behavior Support program that describes the Memorial Elementary School's commitment to providing a safe, caring, and successful school environment for every student in grades 4, 5, and 6. The name represents those qualities that we believe are important to creating a positive academic climate...

*P* = *Pride*

*R* = *Respect*

*I* = *Involvement*

*D* = *Discipline*

*E* = *Education*

The program recognizes and rewards students for good behavior in a variety of settings, including the auditorium, bus stop, cafeteria, classroom, gymnasium, hallway, lavatory, playground, stairwell, and school bus. Students receive special instructions on the *PRIDE Guidelines* for each of these settings during the opening week of the school year. Teachers design Positive Behavior Support lessons to help students show their *Hawkeye Pride*—whether in school, on the bus, or at the playground.

## **Program Goals**

The goals of our *PRIDE* program are summarized below:

### **Pride**

- take pride in your school
- take pride in your family
- take pride in your community
- take pride in yourself

### **Respect**

- show respect for your classmates
- show respect for adults
- show respect for property
- show respect for yourself

### **Involvement**

- attend school on time all the time
- participate in school activities
- participate in community events
- participate in the classroom

### **Discipline**

- listen and follow directions
- obey school rules
- obey classroom teachers
- obey your parents

### **Education**

- come to school prepared
- work to the best of your ability
- appreciate what you have been given
- do your best to be your best...and better

## ***PRIDE* Ticket**

Every day students attend school, *PRIDE* tickets are secretly distributed among the teachers, staff, and bus drivers. As they *catch* students showing their *Hawkeye Pride*, they present them with a *Pride Ticket*. Ticket winners sign the *Celebrity Book* and receive a special certificate. Their names are also read aloud during the morning announcements.

## ***PRIDE* Reminder**

Students who fail to show their *Hawkeye Pride* and display inappropriate behavior in a school setting receive a *PRIDE Reminder*. The *PRIDE Reminder* is not a Disciplinary Referral but does need to be signed by the parent. Several *PRIDE Reminders*, however, can lead to a Disciplinary Referral, although the purpose of the written notices is to encourage and *remind* students to show their *Pride*.

## **Hawkeye *PRIDE* Club**

*PRIDE Ticket* winners become instant members of the *Memorial PRIDE Club*. They draw a number for a designated space on the Club Bulletin Board. Whenever 10 consecutive spaces are filled in a row, column, or diagonal, all 10 ticket-holders receive an individual *Mystery Prize* or can choose a Popcorn Party or Ice Cream Social for their entire homeroom. Every ticket appearing on the Bulletin Board is also eligible for *Grand Prize* drawings at the end of the school year.

## **Homeroom-of-the-Month Student-of-the-Quarter**

Monetary gift cards are also awarded quarterly to the top-performing student in each homeroom, and monthly to the 3 homerooms that display the most *Hawkeye Pride* as determined by their *PRIDE Reminders*, *PRIDE Tickets*, Discipline Referrals, student academic displays, room decorations, locker maintenance, and classroom cleanliness.
